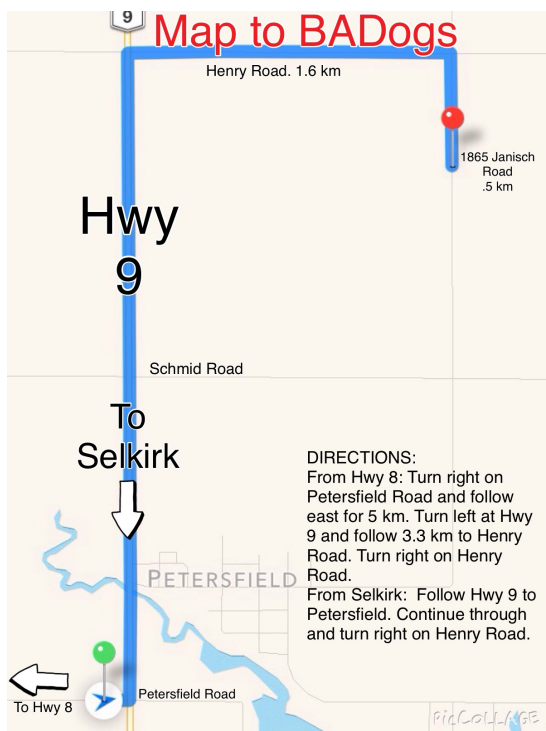
PRIZES AND AWARDS

AIM ELECTRONIC-TIMER SEMINAR

MAL is pleased to be hosting AIM's e-timer Seminar at our first League event. This is a FREE seminar and open to all MAL participants (you don't need to be an AIM member). Get comfortable using the e-timing system with hands-on experience.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS:

Competitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they have read and understood all information within this Premium List, including but not limited to the following:

- 🐾 The Manitoba Agility League is a fun-match style league, designed to encourage learning, cooperation and teamwork.
- 🐾 MAL will follow the rules and regulations of the Agility Association of Canada (AAC).
- 🐾 MAL will include educational components including rules information, agility procedures and training tips.
- 🐾 Dogs MUST BE at least 18 months of age to enter. It is open to all dogs, purebred or mixed breed, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance (coordinators and judges' discretion).
- 🐾 Scorekeeping rules will be modified for MAL at coordinators' discretion.
- 🐾 Dogs MUST be able to perform ALL obstacles in a safe manner.
- 🐾 Number of dogs per team and level of dogs will be set AFTER CLOSING; changes to teams may occur depending on the number of entrants to ensure equity.
- 🐾 Handlers should attend ALL 3 MATCHES and all team members will participate in two runs per match (1 Standard and 1 Game).
- 🐾 The top 3 runs from each team will be used for scoring (subject to change depending on the number of dogs per team).
- 🐾 Scores will be accumulated and combined from all 3 matches.
- 🐾 Each team will be required to volunteer at one match. This includes course building, ring crew, etc.
- 🐾 Dogs exhibiting ANY signs of aggression anywhere on the site (to people or other dogs) will be dismissed; no refund will be given.
- 🐾 MAL has the right to refuse entry to any dog/handler.
- 🐾 Dogs may ONLY be off-leash in the ring. Please ensure that your dog is under control at all times.
- 🐾 All dogs must be crated, penned or leashed when not in the ring and may not be tied to any obstacles, permanent or temporary anywhere on the grounds. Dogs are not to be left unattended unless appropriately crated. Please take responsibility for your dogs and children. Any handler whose dogs or children create unnecessary disturbances or engage in unsafe or disruptive behaviour may be asked to leave the event site. There will be no refunds given if a handler or dog is dismissed from MAL for any reason.
- 🐾 Flat collars without tags, non-squeaking toys and food will be permitted on course. Please be considerate of other dogs in the ring and use only NON CRUMBLING, easy-to-swallow treats. Please do not play with toys near the ring, particularly when other dogs are running.
- 🐾 Please clean up after your dog and yourself; all garbage should be picked up and thrown away. Garbage cans and recycle bins are set up on site.
- 🐾 Kennelling will be outdoors.
- 🐾 MAL is not responsible for any belongings left unattended.
- 🐾 Please follow all signs regarding parking and set up.
- 🐾 All obstacles have been inspected and meet MAL specifications.
- 🐾 After the closing date, refunds will only be given if the dog is injured sufficiently to prevent them from running. MAL coordinators must be informed and a certificate from a veterinarian must be provided.
- 🐾 Bitches in season may not run; no refund will be given.
- 🐾 No entry fee will be refunded if the match or matches cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, Acts of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizers. All attempts to reschedule the event will be made.
- 🐾 All entries will be confirmed via email where an email address is supplied; please ensure it is valid and legible.
- 🐾 Food and drinking water will not be available so please come prepared for yourself and your canine friend. A wading pool will be available for your dogs. Bring your own shade and chair.
- 🐾 No consumption of alcohol is permitted on the show site.
- 🐾 Backyard Agility Dogs is a non-smoking environment. There is no smoking permitted anywhere on the premises. Please smoke in your car. Your cooperation is appreciated.
- 🐾 PLEASE NOTE: Abuse in any form of volunteers, other handlers, dogs or judges will NOT be tolerated.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry by Backyard Agility Dogs/BADogs (the "Organizing Club") and the opportunity to have the Dog participate, compete in and/or be judged at this event, I, the undersigned, agree as follows:

- 1) I certify that I am the actual owner of the Dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner of the Dog and that the Dog is not a hazard to persons, property or other dogs.
- 2) I agree that the Organizing Club for the Event may refuse my entry for any reason that it deems to be sufficient
- 3) I understand and acknowledge that participating in the Event carries certain risks, including, but not limited to injuries (including serious injuries and death) to myself, the Dog, another dog under my control or persons attending as my guests (my "Related Parties"), damage to property and other losses. I waive any and all claims that I have or may have in the future against, and release from all liability and agree not to sue the Organizing Club or any of the co-ordinators, committees, representatives, employees, volunteers or agents of the Organizing Club (the "Personnel") for any injury, death, property damage or loss that I or my Related Parties sustain due to any cause whatsoever, including negligence, breach of contract, breach of duty, statutory or otherwise, or mistakes or errors of judgement of any kind.
- 4) I assume full responsibility for the conduct of myself and my Related Parties during the entirety of the Event. I agree to indemnify save harmless the Organizing Club and the Personnel from and against any and all claims that may be made against them or costs, fees, expenses or liability (including, without limitation, lawyers' fees on a solicitor and own client basis) incurred by the Organizing Club or the Personnel that may arise due to:

(a) Any act or omission of myself, my Related Parties or any party for whom I am liable at law; or

(b) Aggressive behaviour by the Dog or any other dog under my control.

- 5) I understand the rules of competition and the additional rules (if any) for the Event, as well as the policies of Backyard Agility Dogs pertaining to discipline (collectively, the "Rules"). I agree to abide by the Rules and conduct myself and the Dog in accordance with the Rules. I understand that myself and/or the Dog may be subject to disciplinary procedures or sanctions for the breach of the Rules and agree to respect and be bound by any disciplinary decision made by Backyard Agility Dogs.
- 6) I understand that the Organizing Club may, in the course of administering the Event or conducting its activities generally, collect, use or disclose my personal information and that any personal information collected, used or disclosed by the Organizing Club will be treated in accordance with their policy and applicable privacy and personal information laws. I hereby consent to the collection, use and disclosure by the Organizing Club of my personal information.

Media Release and Rights of Privacy Waiver

I Hereby Grant to Backyard Agility Dogs and its affiliated companies, representatives, agents and assigns, all rights and permission to use or appropriate his/her and their dog's name, biography, likeness photograph, voice, performing persona, or other indicia of identity for broadcast, telecast, cablecast, transmission or distribution in any format or media known now or in the future.

Waiver of Rights to Privacy, Publicity & Personality

Further, I hereby release Backyard Agility Dogs and its affiliates, representatives, agents and assigns from any claim or cause of action for invasion of the rights of privacy, right of publicity, right of personality, or any similar rights.

- 7) I have been given the opportunity to read and understand the terms of this Agreement before signing it, and have in fact done so. I understand by signing the Agreement, I am restricting my legal rights and I sign the Agreement voluntarily and of my own free will.

The Personal Information Protection and Electronic Documents Act (PIPEDA) requires that consent be obtained for the collection and use of personal information. The information collected by Backyard Agility Dog will be used for: registering and listing competitors in agility events, submitting results, as required by the sanctioning body, and contacting competitors by email, mail or phone for future agility events such as trials and seminars. The information will be retained by Backyard Agility Dogs and for a period of two (2) years and disposed of in a manner that ensures information protection.

Any dog's moving to Masters will remain in Advanced. Starters dogs will NOT be competing against Advanced dogs.

ADVANCED: for dogs running in Advanced at the time of registration.
 Teams will be made **AFTER** closing. Number of teams and members on each team will depend on number of registrants. You will be contacted after closing with requests for team members. Adjustments may be made by MAL coordinators to balance the number and level of dogs per team to ensure fairness.
