Rebecca McKay began the sport of agility as a hobby 12 years ago and hasn't looked back since. She currently has 4 border collies and a sport mix.

In recent years, a focus on international agility has become a passion. She has been selected to present Canada on 7 world teams. First with her border collie Rush and more recently with her other border collie Shine. Together they have had multiple podium finishes on individual rounds (agility, jumping, snooker and team) and won the Games Biathlon at the 2015 World Agility Championships. Locally, Rush, Shine & Spicy, have won several regional and national titles.

Prior to finding agility Rebecca had a long history of competitive sport involvement. As a junior, she won multiple consecutive medals at Provincial, Regional & National championships in the sport of Swimming, Triathlon & Biathlon. She was selected to represent Canada on two occasions for the World Triathlon Championships and World Biathlon Championships. Now she just jogs and bikes with her dogs for conditioning, but has taken this competitive edge and determination to training agility.

During the week Rebecca is a registered nurse. She also is an instructor with [Shape Up Dogs](#), teaches at seminars, hosts events with Blast Agility ([Blastagility.org](#)) and is a Master AAC Judge.

Seminar Information:

Novice Handling: Focus will be on skill development including, wraps, backsides, threadles, serpentines, and flappy tappies. The day will start at a foundation level and progress towards short sequencing.

Prerequisite: For dogs over 1 year of age. Dogs do not need trial experience but should be able to do sequencing with jumps and tunnels.

Advanced Handling: Focus will be continuation of skill building as well as independence and proofing of those skills in sequences with jumps, tunnels, and/or contacts and weaves.

Prerequisite: Dogs should have experience with sequence work that includes contacts and/or weaves as well as skills such as: wraps, backsides, threadles, serpentines and flappy tappies.

Master Handling: Focus will be on course work, decision making and timing in challenging master level sequences.

Prerequisite: Dogs should be proficient on all obstacles and have been competing at the Master level in the previous trial season.
